


Your Tutor

On warmer days there is an option to paint outside in the garden if you prefer. Bring along your usual watercolour materials, plus extra watercolour paper to try out techniques. If required, paper and a palette of student colours for the day can be provided at a cost of £6, please order these when booking.

All classes run from 10.30am – 4.00pm with a detailed watercolour demonstration, and cream tea. Price also includes all day entrance to the gardens.

A chance to watch lots of delicious wet-into-wet watercolour demonstration.

17 January

Poppies

Such a gorgeous subject, learn how to paint beautiful poppies, with translucent sunlit petals!



7 February

Green Door

Follow a step-by-step demonstration to paint a garden door in loose watercolour, includes lots of useful tips and techniques. (What's behind the Green Door? This leads to the Conservatory, where wedding ceremonies are held at Barnsdale.)



21 March

Daffodil Doodles

How to paint sunlit, translucent, beautifully shaped daffodils without drawing. A really useful technique to learn, whilst being very relaxing and joyful. (You may of course draw them too if you wish.)



18 April

Tea in the Garden

Follow a step-by-step demonstration to paint a summer scene of umbrellas in the outdoor garden cafe in loose watercolour.



16 May

Cow Parsley

A step-by-step demonstration that includes lots of different watercolour techniques such as wax, salt and water droplets to capture this fresh and delicate subject. Easier than you may think.



27 June

Sunlit Pots

There is something adorable about characterful old terracotta pots full of summer flowers. How to paint them, verdigris and all, using delicious wet-into-wet watercolour.



25 July

Campanula

Lovely bell-shaped fresh flowers, we have different varieties at Barnsdale, paint them wet and drippy or more detailed if you wish.

Garden View

How to capture beautiful scenes from Barnsdale with minimum drawing and lots of drippy paint. Alternatively, bring a photograph and use the same techniques to paint your own garden.

A chance to be creative with your flower paintings. Learn how to layer washes to create beautiful lighting effects, then how to paint negative shapes to add impact.

Try out lots of wet-into-wet watercolour techniques including cling film, salt, wax and dropping on colour. Interesting, fun to do and easier than you might think.
